It has come to my attention that some concerns have been expressed among our LIBER

community regarding the situation of the LGBTQIA+ community in Hungary. More recently,

academics also raised concerns over academic freedom, pointing out that the Hungarian

government has further tightened controls over universities and research institutes. These are

sensitive issues, not only for the LGBTQIA+ community, not only for academics, but for LIBER

as an academic and a human community.

I want to say here and now, loud and clear, that LIBER do have inclusivity and respect as part

of our core and fundamental values. We work hard every day, the office together with the

board, to offer a safe environment for everyone taking part in any event organized by LIBER.

It's indeed our commitment and duty to promote our values of diversity, equity and inclusion

everywhere and at all times, especially where and when sensitive concerns are expressed inside

our LIBER community. This is what I am intending to respectfully do in Budapest next July,

delivering my opening speech during our Annual Conference as LIBER President by re-

affirming the values we as the LIBER community are defending, supporting and promoting.

These values are indeed part of our 2023-2027 strategic plan that will be presented in its final

version in Budapest in 2023, I do hope you will be numerous in Budapest to lend support to my

words!
