

LIBER's Rules & Regulations - May 2019 Amendment

Currently LIBER's regulation regarding the cancelling of membership (Participantship) of LIBER by Participants stipulates that six months' notice be given (see Article 5, below):

Article 5 – Termination of Participantship

5.1 Participantship shall be terminated: (a) on resignation which shall be tendered for the end of a calendar year subject to six months' notice and payment of all moneys owing to the Foundation;

In view of the proposal - Ensuing LIBER's Viability & Building on Success - which will be debated and voted on at the Conference and Meeting of Participants in Dublin next month, the Executive Board has proposed that the notice period for cancelling membership be reduced from six months to three. This acknowledges the fact that six months gives very little time for Participants who may wish to cancel their membership from 1 January 2020 to submit notice by 1 July 2019.
