

LIBER ARCHITECTURE GROUP FORUM ANNUAL REPORT 2014-2015

1. Summary

The LAG held its 17th Seminar in Helsinki from 5 to 9 May 2014; it partnered with the Library of the University of Helsinki, which acted as local host and also organised a pre-seminar tour of visits to libraries in and around Helsinki. On the occasion of the Seminar, the LAG published its documentation of new library buildings throughout Europe (in print as well as electronically; cf http://liber-lag.techlib.cz/).

The Seminar attracted about 130 participants, mostly librarians, but also architects and people from university building and development departments.

The Seminar evaluation underlined its overall success: 91% of all the returned questionnaires judged the overall quality of the seminar to be 'excellent' or 'good'; 87% found the chance to network with colleagues interested in the same topics 'excellent' or 'good'; and 89% found the documentation very useful.
