	LIBER libraries are in the exploratory phase and looking to define their role in			
	this area. Outputs and activities in this phase include landscape analysis,			
	guides to getting started, and exploratory workshops with invited experts. The			
	goal is to have a better understanding, have talking points and to sign post			
	how libraries can get started in this area.			
	Embed			
	LIBER libraries are active in this area or starting to get active. At this stage it			
is important to facilitate the sharing of best practice through working gro				
	workshops, positon papers, factsheets. Building capacity through the analysis			
	of skills and training needs is also important. This may be supported through			
	training via webinars, workshops. The goal is to have a continuing dialogue			
	and a support network so that libraries can benefit from a collaborative			
	approach.			
	Engage			
	Although constantly evolving, LIBER libraries are very active in this area and			
	are seeking to reinforce their activities by engaging in an international library			
	network or by collaborating with other stakeholders. They have a relatively			
	clear view of the landscape and are positioned to take a leading role. Examples			
	of activities and outputs in this area include positon statements, EU projects,			
	collaboration with other organisations, training, and workshops.
