How to survive in the world of architects and building department

Abstract

On the background of three interrelated large building projects for the Royal Library, Copenhagen, from 1991 till 1999 this contribution focuses on how the library became an influential actor in the building process.

It describes its position in the formal decision structure involving Ministry, Architects and Building Directorate, and it describes its strategy for being an influential actor during the whole building process.

The contribution also gives an outline for new building projects on the way 2004.
