

Marco De Michelis (1945) is the dean of the faculty of arts and design at the IUAV University in Venice, He was a fellow of the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation (Berlin and Munich) and a scholar at the Getty Center for the History of Arts in Santa Monica, CA. From 1999 to 2003 he was appointed the Walter Gropius Professor for the history of architecture at the Bauhaus University in Weimar. 2005 he has been appointed Mellon Senior Fellow at the CCA/Montreal.

He has published extensively about contemporary architecture, including Heinrich Tessenow (Stuttgart/DVA and Milan/Electa 1991); Walter Gropius, Ludwig Hilberseimer (special issues of "Rassegna", 1983 and 1986); Bauhaus 1919-1933 (Milan/Mazzotta 1996); Luis Barragan (Milan/Skira 2000); Enric Miralles (Milan/Skira 2002).

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
