Responsibilities

- You act as a catalyst in the implementation and integration of digital collections and digital tools in Artes, whether project based or business as usual. In order to do this, you create partnerships which support Artes' strategic objectives in acquiring digital content, exploiting the collection in digital ways, and fostering digital scholarship.

- You actively participate in relevant networks of expertise or work groups within KU Leuven and KU Leuven Libraries.
- You actively participate in national and international meetings and conferences concerning digital scholarship in the Humanities, representing Artes and KU Leuven Libraries.

For all these tasks as expert Digital Scholarship in the Humanities, you report to the Head of Artes.

- You hold a MA degree, preferably in the Arts and Humanities (history or art history), and an additional degree (or comparable experience) in Computer or Information Science.
- Proven ability in the application for research projects and/or project management is an asset.
- Experience with digital humanities and more particularly the role of libraries within digital humanities is an asset.
- You have analytic skills and a demonstrable ability to translate the need of researchers, teaching staff and students in the Arts and Humanities in technical and functional requirements.
- You are a team player and collaborate well with colleagues.
- You are enterprising, work well under pressure and have a sense for innovation and quality.
- You are committed to continuous learning.
- You have excellent communication skills in English. If you do not speak or write Dutch, you are required to master the language in a period of under three years.
