### ANNUAL REPORT (2015-2016)

## NAME OF FORA: LIBER Architecture Group CHAIR: Ulrich Niederer

#### • SUMMARY

The LIBER Architecture Group met four times in the past two years in order to organise its 18<sup>th</sup> seminar, which was hosted by the University of Freiburg Library. It took place from 12 to 16 April 2016 and had 130 participants, many librarians, but also a sizeable number of architects and building project managers. The pre-seminar tour included visits to two libraries in Strasbourg; participants had further opportunities to visit libraries on the first and second day of the seminar, among which an in-depth visit accompanied by presentations on the new Freiburg University Library.

The Group again published its documentation of new library buildings throughout Europe, this time online only; it is open access and can be downloaded via the Group's or the LIBER Architecture Forum websites. Furthermore, the Group discussed ways of maintaining and keeping the database hosted by the Czech National Library of Technology in Prague.

### GOAL 1: Seminar in April 2016 in Freiburg, Germany

### STATUS: Achieved
